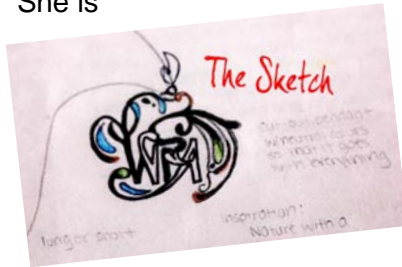


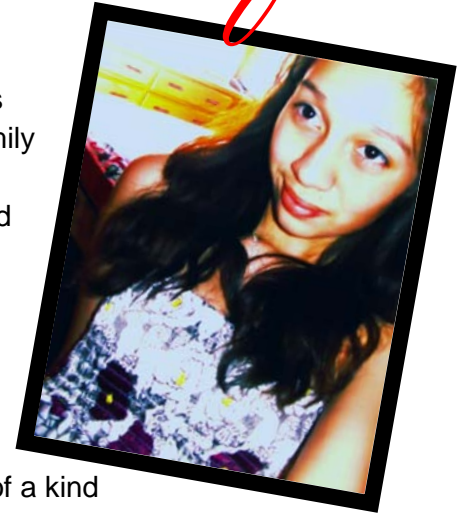

Each student made submissions including detailed sketches showing creativity, originality, and viability and a written piece explaining inspirational history. The winning logo/design was adorned onto fine silver jewelry as a WPA bangle bracelet and WPA Charm Bracelet.

The winner of the Jewelry Challenge was Cindy Ramirez, junior, West Potomac High School. Evelyn Brooks Designs will present her with a \$100 gift certificate and a WPA Bangle showcasing her winning design.
